BOARD EXAM RESULTS 2024-25

Class XII Toppers



A crescendo of academic brilliance resounds as our Grade 12 scholars etch their legacy in excellence! With 153 students appearing and achieving a phenomenal 100% pass rate, the highest aggregate touched 97.4% and the school average stood at a commendable 82.9%. A total of 609 distinctions were earned, with 42 students scoring above 90% and 60 between 80–89%. We proudly applaud our toppers—Palak Bhanot and Yashvi Wadhwa (97.4%), Bhavya Sharma (97.2%), and Keerat Kaur (96.4%)—along with those who achieved perfect 100s. Their achievements reflect resilience, ambition, and the spirit of excellence that defines our school.

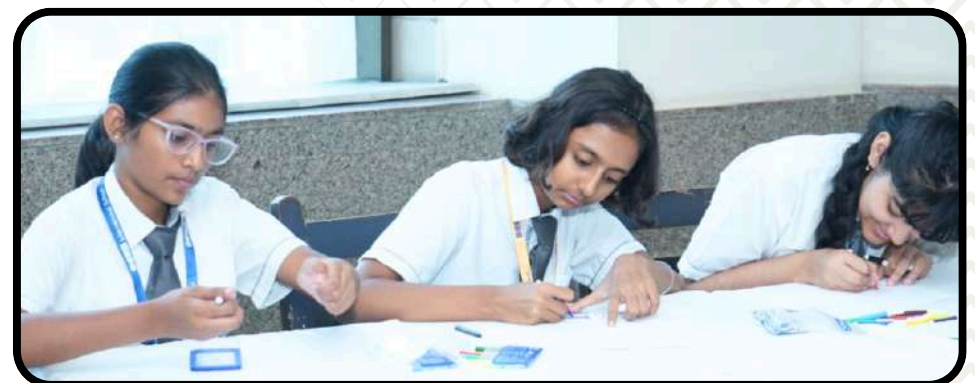
SCHOLAR BADGE CEREMONY

TERRA CARE WEEK

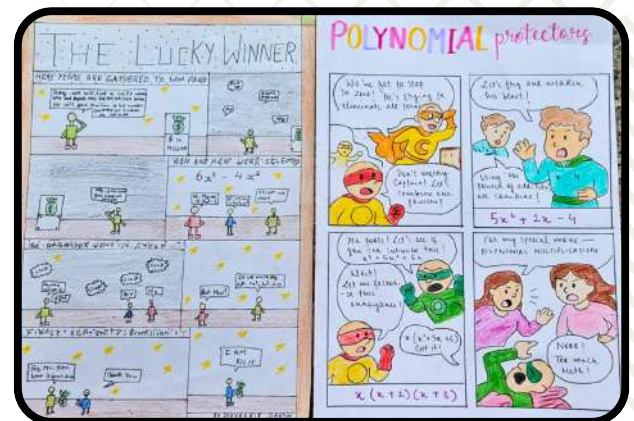
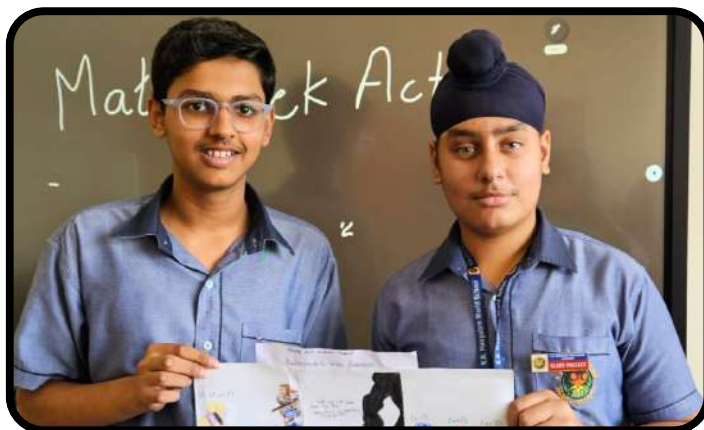

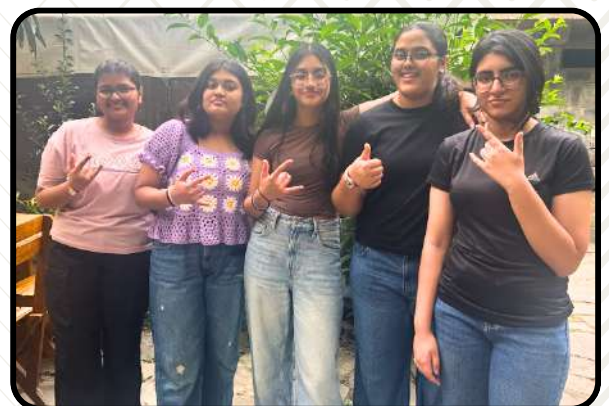


TRIPS AND EXCURSIONS

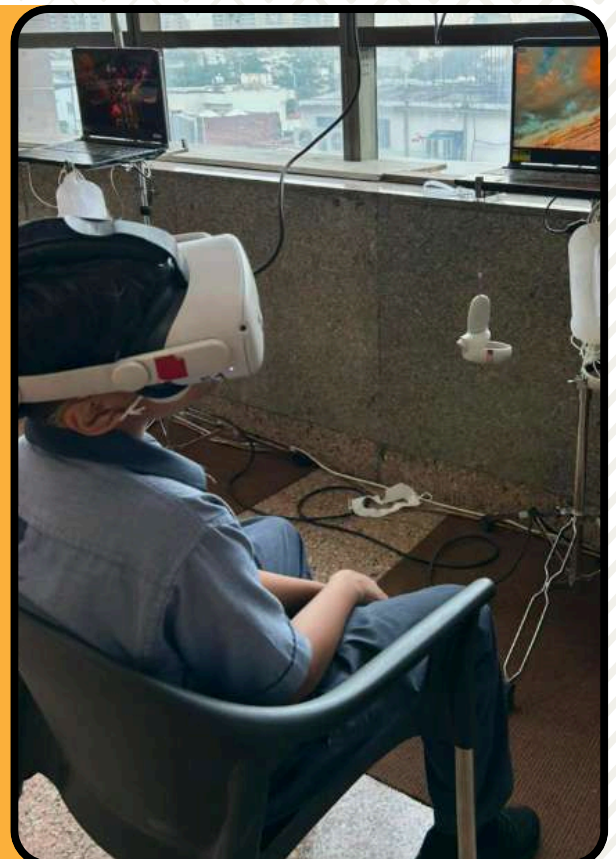

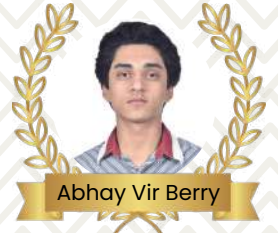
